Inspired Action

The creation of Lifeline Productions and the world premiere of *Clowns Like Me* was years in the making. I am first and foremost a father. My eldest son has struggled his entire life with multiple mental health issues, so the escalating mental health crises in this country is deeply personal for me. The lack of adequate funding to address these issues is one part of the problem, but even more painful is the stigma surrounding mental illness and the marginalization of those whose suffer. A few years ago, I began to talk with Scott about possibly telling his mental health story on stage. I imagined putting these two pieces together—theatre and mental illness—could result in something authentic and empowering. And not just for Scott, but for the public as well. Clowns Like Me is not an end. It's the beginning. We are going to tell more stories each year to continue the conversations necessary for society-wide healing.


Nearly half of those who commit suicide each year suffer from a known mental health condition.

Clowns Like Me debuted to sold-out audiences and rave reviews in May 2023 at the Cook Theatre, and had a second run at the Cook Theatre in August with over 1,300 attendees moved by Scott's message. Lifeline is currently developing connections for a national, and international tour of Clowns Like Me as well as screenings for our film product. Our exciting new production will debut during National Mental Health Awareness Month May 2024.
